ERASMUS FOR YOUNG ENTREPRENEURS SUMMARY SHEET

The European exchange program for entrepreneurs.

Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs helps provide aspiring European entrepreneurs with the skills necessary to start and/or successfully run a small business in Europe. New entrepreneurs gather and exchange knowledge and business ideas with an experienced entrepreneur, with whom they stay and collaborate for a period of 1 to 6 months. The stay is partly financed by the European Commission.

Objective

The present call for proposals will support actions for organisations enhancing and facilitating the mobility of new entrepreneurs.

The purpose of the call is to select a number of projects submitted by public or private entities, individually or in partnerships composed of at least two entities from one or several Participating Countries. They will be required to cooperate with all other organisations and authorities involved in the mobility programme, enabling new entrepreneurs to take part in mobility activities as agreed. They will receive support from the existing Support Office. The expected outputs of the present call are:

- enabling new entrepreneurs to spend time with and learn from a host entrepreneur in another Competitiveness and Innovation Programme (CIP) Participating Country;
- creating new businesses, joint ventures and spin-off companies and foster cross-border business cooperation;
- further developing a network of new entrepreneurs, host entrepreneurs and Intermediary Organisations;
- enhancing the international activities and innovation potential of host entrepreneurs.

The PROPOSAL: ERASMUS FOR YOUNG ENTREPRENEURS CARE - EYE CARE

The activities to be implemented under this proposal are as follows:

- (a) Promotion of the programme;
- (b) Enrolment of entrepreneurs;
- (c) Assessing applications from NEs and HEs;
- (d) Building relationships;
- (e) Management of contracts and commitments and financial assistance;
- (f) preparation of the exchange;
- (g) follow up of the exchange;
- (h) management, quality control and evaluation;
- (i) Active networking;
- (j) Reporting.
