## The Entity

The Extremadura Agency for International Development Cooperation (AEXCID) is the management body for Extremadura cooperation, which combats poverty and works for sustainable human development. The Agency reports to the Regional Government of Extremadura through the Regional Ministry of Labor, Women and Social Policy in Extremadura.

Extremadura has been doing development cooperation actions for three decades as a pioneering region in the panorama of decentralized cooperation in areas such as, basic social services, rural development, governance democratic, human rights defense, protection of people at risk of social exclusion with focus on target groups of discrimination based on gender, race or ethnicity, religion or belief. Among our programs we have cooperate in the development of the Program called "Youth in Cooperation" which is an initiative of the Government of Extremadura, designed to generate a pool of young professionals in the field of International Cooperation for Development, one of the goals is the improvement of the quality of the frontier cooperation.

In this context, and due to the many challenges that both developing and developed countries will have to tackle in the coming decade a key one will be training and employment, we are planning a pionering scheme to support young people commitment in development.

### THE IDEA

**Title:** Let's Cooperate through a European vision: The side of the European Cooperation in the youth field.

It's an innovative proposal designed to support young people engagement in development EU projects and Programs as a way to strengthen their professional and intercultural skills and to reinforce project implementation capacity.

The project aims to promote the European cooperation in the youth field through the exchanges among Institution active in the field of youth or International Development Cooperation (Youth Organization, Policy makers and NGDO's) from different World-contexts (Italy, Spain, France,....) through Seminars, and training of young, considering the field experience as a key factor for this purpose.

- **To contribute** to the capacity building of youth organization, policy makers and NGDO's active in international development cooperation in order to submit proposal in the field of the European Commission.

- To foster cooperation and exchanges among youth workers in the framework on International Development Cooperation.
- **To encourage** the skills and abilities of European youth who want to focus their professional future in the field of International Development Cooperation through the training in European Development cooperation tools (such us, European Programs, European financial tools, ...) in order to contribute to the reinforces of their abilities, thereby combat youth unemployment in Europe.
