-> Ageing of the population identified as one of the main challenges to be faced by Franche-Comté region in the coming years.

-> According to Eurostat projections, Burgundy to be the 4th region in Europe most struck by the ageing of its population by 2020.

Examples of European projects

- AAL Joint Programme | MEDiATE -> research project on a solution to improve communication between formal and informal carers for the elderly (launched on June 13th 2013)
- 7th FP | FALL WATCH -> development of a wearable miniaturized fall detection system for the elderly
- ICT-PSP | AFE-INNOVNET -> network of 29 partners on innovation for age-friendly environments (submitted)



Other initiatives

- World Health Organization | Dijon and Besançon, labelled « Agefriendly cities » (among 6 cities in France)
- Open Days 2012 | organisation of a seminar in partnership with 5 other European regions on « Healthy Ageing : acting for innovation at regional and local level »
- SENIOR'ACT | collaborative project with SMEs for the food and drinks industry to adapt their products and services to the elderly
- COHORTE ICE | large scale research programme over 10 years, on 7000 informal carers in two regions
