I am pleased to inform you of the launch of the preparatory action of the Erasmus for local and regional elected representatives. This new initiative of the European Commission, which was developed following the initiative of the European Parliament and in collaboration with the CoR, aims at increasing the knowledge of local and regional elected representatives on strategic planning within the Cohesion Policy, encouraging multilateral cooperation between local and regional institutions and promoting the exchange of best practices through ad hoc training and transnational learning activities.

The project will take place between autumn 2012 and spring 2013 and will consist of three obligatory steps: 1) participation in five Open Days 2012 seminars, 2) on-site visit to an EU city/region, 3) participation in two-day closing seminar in Brussels.
