

Info Day - EU funding for the tourism sector

The Multi-Annual Financial Framework (MFF) for 2014-2020 brings simplification at various levels: merger of EU funding programmes for easier access to information, harmonisation of application procedures, ... The MFF also introduced the possibility to support new types of actions.

Gathering and digesting this information is easier than before, but it remains a challenge for hard-pressed private and public entities promoting tourism destinations or developing tourism services.

The info day will therefore <u>focus on the most important EU programmes</u> for the tourism sector, <u>around practical questions</u>: type of tourism-related actions eligible for funding; type and level of funding; who can apply; how to apply.

Programmes covered include COSME, European Regional Development fund, European Agriculture and Rural Development Fund, Creative Europe Programme, ...
